Amy Beros is a dedicated leader in the philanthropic sector, having spent more than a decade developing and implementing strategic development plans to empower nonprofit organizations.

Passionate about advancing causes that are changing people's lives, Amy currently serves as Managing Director, Strategic Capacity Development at Feeding America. In this role, Amy assists the development departments of 200 food bank partners throughout the country, building up their ability to raise necessary funds to fight hunger in their local communities.

Amy's experience advocating for stronger food security runs deep. As Vice President of Development at the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina, Amy built the Food Bank's first major gift program and completed a \$10,000,000 capital campaign for a new facility. Amy led a team of thirty-two staff, with an annual revenue goal of \$12M, oversaw four food bank branch operations, and management of more than 25,000 volunteers.

Prior to the Food Bank, Amy led development efforts for Inter-Faith Food Shuttle and was the Director of Corporate Partnerships for Easter Seals UCP NC & VA. She also serves as a board member of the North Carolina Dietetics and Nutrition.

A graduate of Clemson University, Amy earned an MBA from DePaul University in Chicago. Amy currently resides outside Raleigh with her husband and two young children.
