Cindy Galindo is a philanthropic professional with more than two decades of experience in higher education, academic medicine and private and family philanthropy.

In February 2018, she was appointed the Chief Development Officer for the Archdiocese of Los Angeles. In this role, she oversees all existing philanthropic efforts, and is charged with growing the program in the coming years.

For more than 14 years, Cindy worked at the University of Southern California. Most recently she served as the executive director of development and strategic initiatives where she was a member of the health sciences development leadership team responsible for raising \$1.5 billion for the university's medical enterprise – the largest portion of USC's \$6 billion Campaign for the University of Southern California. In addition to her tenure at USC, she has held positions at California Institute of Technology, Claremont McKenna College, Alverno High School and Whittier Family Foundations/Whittier Trust Company.

An Oregon native, Cindy received her bachelor's degree from Oregon State University and her master's in public administration from Portland State University.
