34% of healthcare organizations increased their fundraising staff, while 73% increased staff pay by 1-10% over the past three years. The top two engagement tactics for physician's involvement in fundraising efforts include participating in recognition and stewardship efforts (35%) and participating in outreach initiatives (33%).


41% get 20% or less of their giving in the form of noncash assets.



73% expect major and mid-level gifts and annual appeals to increase in 2024.



60% describe their organization's reporting and analytics capabilities at a leading level or higher of sophistication.



51% have not addressed the use of Al technology in their operations.



**54%** of healthcare organizations organize fundraising efforts (e.g., major gifts, annual fund) by a combination of geography (3%), hospital facility (5%), and service line (8%). Others (32%) organize their efforts by other means, such as fundraising channels.
